Notwithstanding the provisions of point 1(b) of the document referred to in the preceding sentence, a person who is an employee of the company, a subsidiary or affiliate, as well as a person associated with those entities under a contract of a similar nature, cannot be considered as meeting the criteria for independence. A dependent relationship with a shareholder which excludes independence of a supervisory board member in the meaning of this policy shall also mean a real and important relationship with the shareholder holding at least 5% of the total number of votes in the company ",
